

GRL Visiting Program

The Gender Research Library (GRL) at Nagoya University is inviting applicants for Visiting Scholars through its Visiting Program.

The Visiting Program aims to bring researchers in gender studies to the GRL for extended visits. Visiting Scholars will have the opportunity to carry out independent gender-related research at the GRL and interact with scholars at the GRL and Nagoya University. The length of stay is negotiable (from 1 week to 12 months). The GRL will provide travel expenses and a private office room. Visiting Scholars must conduct one research seminar (no teaching duties) at the GRL and contribute a report to *GRL Studies*.

This program is suitable for researchers on sabbatical and Ph.D. candidates writing for dissertations, but others may also apply.

Eligibility

Applicants should hold a Ph.D. or be a Ph.D. candidate in a relevant field and be affiliated with universities and other research institutions outside Japan.

From 1 week to 12 months

Application Instructions

Applicants should submit:

1. a CV including a list of publications
2. a proposal of 1-2 pages containing a brief description of their previous research and the research they plan to conduct during the visit to the GRL
3. a plan for their stay at the GRL, including when and how long they will be at the GRL

Applications received by May 31st, 2025, are guaranteed full consideration.
