GRL Studies Submission Guidelines

GRL Studies Editorial Committee Established: August 5, 2025

1. Originality

All manuscripts submitted to this journal must be unpublished.

2. Language

Manuscripts should be written in either Japanese or English.

Authors whose native language is not English must have their manuscripts checked by a native English speaker before submission.

3. Length Requirements

- Articles in English: Up to 8,000 words, including notes, tables/figures, and references.
- Research Notes in English: Up to 6,000 words including notes, figures, tables, and references.

4. Required Files and Component

- (1) Cover Page: Full title of the manuscript, author(s) name(s) in, and affiliation(s) (Affiliation(s) may be omitted)
- (2) Abstract:
 - For Articles: Up to 300 words.
 - For Research Notes: Up to 200 words.
- (3) Keywords: 3–5 words; place at the end of abstract.
- (4) Main Text: Includes headings, subheadings, notes, acknowledgments, references, and tables/figures. The character/word count excludes the cover page, abstract, and keywords.
- (5) Tables and Figures: Insert in a single file (formats accepted: Word, Excel, JPEG, PNG) separate from the main text.

5. Copyright

Copyright for all published manuscripts belong to the Nagoya University Gender Research Library.

Authors wishing to reprint their work must obtain prior written permission through the *GRL Studies* Editorial Committee.

6. Digital Publication

Accepted manuscripts will be published electronically via the Nagoya University Gender Research Library website and the Nagoya University Repository.

7. Proofreading

Authors may proofread their manuscripts up to two times.

8. Withdrawal

If an author wishes to withdraw a manuscript after publication, they must promptly notify the Editorial Committee.
